R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines per Rule 31.3 of G.O. No. 95

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has, by letter dated June 12, 1958, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Fifth Avenue, Don Julian Avenue, Sixth Avenue, Valley Boulevard, Orange Avenue, Nelson Avenue, Vineland Avenue, Francisquito Avenue, and West Ramona Boulevard, all being in Los Angeles County, Northwest of La Puente, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of Commission permission, such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: General Telephone Company of California, the communication utility in the area, by letter dated July 29, 1957, has indicated no objection to such occupancy,

IT IS FOUND that the request for permission should be granted Southern California Edison Company, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Fifth Avenue, Don Julian Avenue, Sixth Avenue, Valley Boulevard, Orange Avenue, Nelson Avenue, Vineland Avenue, Francisquito Avenue, and West Ramona Boulevard, all located in Los Angeles County, northwest of La Puente, substantially as shown on the drawing marked 4305-0897, comprising two sheets, submitted with the company's letters of June 25, 1957 and June 12, 1958.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
