SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules  
 Which May Result in Increased Rates or Charges


WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, by Advice No. 77 filed on September 26, 1958, having requested authority to place in effect in the City of San Bernardino a new Schedule LS-1, Lighting - Street and Highway - Company-Owned Installations, as set forth on Original Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 1240-E, to become effective on October 26, 1958, which new tariff may result in more restrictive conditions and minor increases in charges for future customers, and

WHEREAS: It appearing that such conditions or charges as will result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 1240-E effective on October 26, 1958.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution E-1002 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
