SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Rule No. 14,
 Shortage of Supply and Interruption of Delivery.

WHEREAS: California Oregon Power Company, by Advice No. 91, filed on November 14, 1958, having requested authority to deviate from its filed Rule No. 14, Shortage of Supply and Interruption of Delivery, to the extent of using a standard form of electric service contract with an absolving clause when furnishing service over lines and electric facilities of uncertain duration or owned by a third party, and

WHEREAS: Such a deviation will not increase any rate or charge, nor conflict with other rules, and will be in the public interest, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 534-E effective on December 14, 1958.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet made effective in accordance with the order herein shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution No. E-1005 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
