WHEREAS: **Southern California Edison Company, by Advice No. 265 filed  
 December 31, 1958, having requested authority to revise its Rule No. 7,  
 Deposits, as set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2882-E, to  
 become effective on January 30, 1959, which new tariff sheet may result  
 in more restrictive conditions for some customers, and**

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public
