SUBJECT: Permission to Deviate from Rule 92.1-F of General Order No. 95 subject: with Respect to Clearance between Transformer Case and

Television (Communication) Cable

THE BIXTHE T.V. CABLE SYSTEM, by letter dated July 7, 1956 WHEREAS requested permission to deviate from Rule 92.1-F of General Order No. 95, with regard to vertical clearance of 40 inches between a transformer case and a television cable at four pole locations only, and

WHEREAS; It is impractical to obtain the vertical clearance and in lieu of this vertical clearance, a horizontal clearance of 3 feet and a vertical clearance of 1-foot from the transformer case is required which will provide adequate climbing and working space, and

WHEREAS: The Galifornia Electric Power Company, owners of the transformer pole structures, by letter December 11, 1958, approved such clearances.

IT IS HEREEF ORDERED that permission be granted The Blythe T.V. Cable System to deviate from the vertical provisions of Rule 92.1-F(1) at four locations, nemely in the alley north of Hobson Way: the pole west side of Broadway, the two poles west of Spring St., and the pole west of Main St., provided the television cable is not less than 1-foot vertically below and 3 feet horizontally from the plane of the mearest surface of the transformer case.
