SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "IF" Lines per Rule 31.3 of G.O. No. 95

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has, by letter dated May 11, 1959, requested authorization to occupy with Class "W" circuits both sides of Jensen Avenue from Del Bay Avenue to Bethel Avenue a distance of 5,199 feet near Senger, Presso County and

WHEREAD: In the absence of Commission permission, such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95 and

MHEREAS: THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEFRAPH COMPANY, and the SANGER TELEPHONE COMPANY, the only other pole using utilities in the area, by letters dated April 23 and April 20, 1959 respectively have indicated no objection to the proposed occupancy.

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted the PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, and good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that permission be granted the PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order Ho. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Jensen Avenue from Del Rey Avenue to Bethel Avenue for a distance of 5,199 feet more or less near Sanger, Fresno County and substantially as shown on the plan map, Drawing No. 8-37512 submitted with the company's letter of May 11, 1959.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
