R E S O L U T I O N

**SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules
 Which May Result in Increased Rates or Charges**

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 266, filed May 1, 1959, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules, as designated in its Schedules A-3 and A-4, General Service; and Schedules B-3 and B-4, Domestic Service, Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2894-E, 2895-E, 2899-E and 2900-E, respectively, to include the area annexed by the City of Bellflower by Ordinance No. 37 in Rate Zone No. 3; and to include the area annexed by the City of Port Hueneus by Resolution No. 504.2 in Rate Zone No. 4, and

WHEREAS: Said revisions may result in a technical increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code; and

WHEREAS: Such increased rates or charges as may result from such revisions are hereby found to be justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted to make the above revisions effective on May 31, 1959.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such revisions were authorized by Resolution E-1028 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
