SUBJECT: Minimum Requirements for Customer Owned Service and Metor Poles

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC FORM COMPANY has, by letters dated February 18, and May 4, 1959, requested approval of the Commission to issue revised standard drawings for customer owned service and meter poles, which drawings contain minor deviations from the requirements of General Order No. 95, and

EMERGAS: The revised drawings are in accordance with recognized practices and are in the interest of uniformity of safety practices among the major utilities,

IT IS FOUND that the authority granted by Resolution No. E-686 should be terminated and superseded by authorization to issue revised drawings on the same subject and good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREMY ORDERED that the further issuance of, and construction of facilities in accordance with, drawings authorized by Resolution No. 5-686 be terminated.

IT IS HEREEY FURTHER ORDERED that permission be granted the GALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY and its customers to deviate from this Commission's General Order No. 95 to the extent shown on said company's "Customer Owned Service and Meter Pole" Standard Drawings Nos. S-Ol6 and 3-Ol7 as enclosed with its letters dated February 18, 1959 and May 74, 1959.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that such drawings issued may bear the following statement:

"Construction of facilities in accordance with this drawing authorized by Sesolution No. 2-1029, dated June 2, 1959, of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
