SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules
Which May Result in Increased Rates or Charges

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 87- filed July 17, 1959, having requested authority to make revisions in tariff schedules, as designated in Rate Case Maps Nos 6 and 7, Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1270-E and 1271-E, and

WHEREAS: Said revisions may result in a technical increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission under Section 434 of the Public Utilities Code; and

WHEREAS: Such increased rates or charges as may result from such revisions are hereby found to be justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted to make the above revisions effective on August 16, 1959.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such revisions were authorized by Resolution 2-1078 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
