SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Tariff Schedule SE.

WHEREAS: California Electric Power Company, by letter dated August 25, 1959, having requested authority to waive a Service Establishment Charge in the amount of \$1,292 payable by the United States Government, March Air Force Base, California, and

WHEREAS: Said waiver of charges will be a deviation from its filed tariff Schedule SE, Service Establishment Charges, requiring authorization by the Commission under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code, and


WHEREAS: Such deviation from its filed tariff Schedule SE is hereby found to be just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted California Electric Power Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to waive a service establishment charge of \$1,292 previously rendered the United States Government, March Air Force Base, on invoices dated November 28, 1958 and January 7, 1959.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
