SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Amendment to Contract for Electric Service

- WHEREAS: 1. PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 600-E, filed June 21, 1977, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code, to amend its existing electric extension agreement with Boise Cascade Recreation Communities Corporation (Boise) to reflect the fact that Rancho Calaveras Corporation, a California corporation not affiliated with Boise, purchased lots in bulk and does not plan to make arrangements with PG&E to provide electric service to the sold lots.
- 2. Electrical extensions required to serve the sold lots shall be made available at the cost of the purchasers of said sold lots in accordance with the then currently applicable provisions of PG&E's tariff Rule No. 15, Section B. or Section E.7.
- 3. The agreement provides for refunds to repay advances for extensions previously paid by Boise prior to the date of the amendment or which are paid in the future as to lots previously sold and paid by purchasers of the sold lots according to the order of such extensions, as provided in Sections B.3.b.(4) and C.3.d. of PG&E's tariff Rule No. 15.
- 4. It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with established procedures, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on ratepayers, and are hereby found to be just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appears.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective July 19, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
