SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Amendment to Contract between Boise Cascade Recreation Communities Corporation and Pacific Gas and Electric Company for Electric Line Extension

WHEREAS: 1. PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 600-E, filed June 21, 1977, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code, to amend its existing electric extension agreement with Boise Cascade Recreation Communities Corporation (Boise) for the Rancho Calaveras Subdivision (Subdivision).

2. The existing agreement requires Boise to pay for any line extension charges within the Subdivision.

3. Rancho Calaveras Corporation (Rancho) has purchased lots in bulk from Boise and does not plan to make arrangements with PG&E to provide electric service to these lots.

4. Electrical line extension will be provided in accordance with PG&E's Tariff Rule 15.

5. The amendment provides for refunds to repay advances for extensions paid for by Boise.

6. It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with established procedures, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on ratepayers, and are hereby found to be just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appears.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective August 16, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
