SUBJECT: Order authorizing contract between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Jerome J. Moiso dba Rancho Borando Madrone to install an overhead electric line extension.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) by Advice Letter No. 610-E filed August 24, 1977, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement dated May 5, 1977 with Jerome J. Moiso dba Rancho Borando Madrone (Rancho) covering construction of an overhead electric extension within Rancho Borando Madrone located in Monterey County.

Rancho will pay to PG&E an advance of \$6,980 representing the difference between the estimated cost to PG&E of furnishing and installing facilities and three times the estimated annual revenues from domestic load plus six times the estimated annual revenues from general service loads plus four times the estimated annual revenues from agricultural loads.

In addition to the advance, Rancho will pay a cost of ownership fund of \$5,873.28, which is the present worth of PG&E's annual ownership costs for the facilities (12% of advance) for a period of ten years.

Refunds or adjustments of the advance and cost of ownership fund will be made based on the added or removed loads, for a period of ten years.

Any unrefunded balance of the advance at the end of ten years will be retained by PG&E. Any unused balance of the cost of ownership fund will be refunded to Rancho.

It is found that the provisions of this contract will not result in a burden on other ratepayers and are not discriminatory; therefore, good cause appears.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective September 23, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
