**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing special agreement between Southern California Edison Company and Clear Creek Canyon Homeowners Association for electric service for residential walkway lighting located within Diamond Bar Subdivision, Los Angeles County.

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (Edison) by Advice Letter No. 447-E filed September 29, 1977, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement dated August 16, 1977 with Clear Creek Canyon Homeowners Association (Clear Creek) to supply electric service for residential walkway lighting on a mutually agreed modification of Schedule No. DWL (Domestic Walkway Lighting). Service is to be rendered under this special agreement as a deviation from Edison's Schedule No. DWL.

This deviation is requested because FHA's financial practice does not provide for utility furnished walkway lighting facilities.

This special agreement with Clear Creek provides a modified DWL rate in consideration of a developer furnished, nonrefundable advance for the DWL facilities within the tract.

Schedule No. DWL is modified by the agreement, to reduce the effective monthly lamp charge by \$2.22. The customer will pay the energy cost adjustment provided under Special Condition No. 5 in the DWL schedule.


It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with procedures for residential lighting facilities, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on ratepayers, and are just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted Southern California Edison Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective October 29, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
