R E S O L U T I O N

**SUBJECT:** California-Pacific Utilities Company, order authorizing electric tariff filing for purchased power adjustment to decrease annual revenue an aggregate \$11,028 or 0.14%.

**WHEREAS:** CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 159-E filed October 4, 1977, requests authority to change its purchased power adjustment billing factors to become effective November 1, 1977.

Such filing complies with procedures and timing authorized by Decisions Nos. 82711, dated April 9, 1974, and 83642, dated October 22, 1974, and contained in Part F of the Preliminary Statement.

The proposed revenue changes and the resulting purchased power adjustment factors are shown in the following table.

The increases shown for Lassen and Weaverville corresponds to an increase in PG&E's resale rates authorized by the FPC and effective September 1, 1977.

The decrease shown for Needles is an annualized decrease in Nevada Power's resale rates authorized by the FPC and effective June 1, 1977.

The increase in average rate per kilowatt-hour since January 1, 1976 is 45.5% for Lassen Division, 35.8% for Weaverville Division, and 29.6% for Needles Division.

No change is made in rates for lifeline usages.

The present and proposed domestic rates and the effect on these rates on the winter average bill are shown in the following tables:
