**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing contract between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and R. P. Rust (Developer) for construction of an overhead electric distribution system.

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) by Advice Letter No. 612-E filed September 20, 1977, requests authority under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement dated July 12, 1977 with R. P. Rust (Rust) covering the installation of an overhead electric distribution facility within Rancho Huasna subdivision near Arroya Grande, San Luis Obispo County.

Rust will pay to PG&E an advance of \$13,586 representing the total cost of the distribution system, plus annual ownership charges of 1% per month of the advance for continuing costs of ownership.

Refunds of the advance will be made annually in accordance with PG&E's tariff Rule No. 15, Section C.3.


This subdivision has a minimum lot size of 5 acres and satisfies the requirements of Section C.1.b of Rule No. 15, requiring a minimum lot size of 3 acres, for overhead extensions to serve developments.

It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with established procedures, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on ratepayers and are just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective November 1, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
