SUBJECT: Order authorizing special agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Heilmann Brothers covering the installation of overhead electric distribution facilities.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) by Advice Letter No. 629-E filed October 17, 1977, requests authority in accordance with Section X-A of General Order No. 96-A, to carry out the terms and conditions of a special agreement dated September 15, 1977 with Heilmann Brothers (Heilmann) covering the installation of an overhead electric distribution system to serve a residence, an agricultural pump and hog farm on private property in San Luis Obispo County.

Heilmann will pay PG&E \$11,710 representing the difference between the estimated total cost to PG&E for furnishing and installing this facility and the amount of money that will support this facility based on estimated annual revenues of two times the domestic load plus four times the agricultural pumping and farm loads.

Heilmann will also pay a monthly charge of 1% of the advance for cost of ownership expense to PG&E.

Refunds or adjustments of the advance and cost of ownership fund will be made based on the added or removed loads.

It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with procedures for installation of overhead facilities, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on other ratepayers, and are just and reasonable; therefore good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out ther terms and conditions of said agreement effective November 22, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
