SUBJECT: Order authorizing contract between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Kaiser Aetna covering the installation of electric underground facilities to provide service to Mountain View Business Park.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) by Advice Letter No. 618-E filed October 3, 1977, requests authority in accordance with Section X-A of General Order No. 96-A to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement dated May 6, 1976 with Kaiser Aetna (Kaiser) covering the installation of underground facilities to provide service to Mountain View Business Park in Santa Clara County.

Kaiser will furnish and install the basic electric underground facilities within the development and will convey these to PG&E. When details of the exact load requirements within the development are known, PG&E will complete the installation of the facilities necessary to provide service.

Until two or more customers request service within the development, PG&E will own and operate the facility under the exceptional cases provision of electric tariff Rule No. 15.2. Under this provision Kaiser will pay PG&E an advance of \$2,344 which is PG&E's estimate of the cost of facilities plus cost of ownership charges of \$23.44 monthly, which is 1% of the advance.

When two or more accounts' monthly billings exceed three times the monthly cost of ownership to PG&E for the facilities, the advance of \$2,344 will be available for refund to Kaiser in accordance with Rule No. 15.2.

It is found that the provisions of this agreement are consistent with established procedures, are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on ratepayers, and are just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement effective November 22, 1977. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
