SUBJECT: Order to amend Resolution No. E-l706 between Sierra Pacific Power Company and Occidential Land Inc.

WHEREAS: SIERRA PACIFIC POWER COMPANY (Sierra) by Advice Letter No. 125-E filed October 31, 1977, requests authority to amend an agreement dated July 19, 1977 between Sierra and Occidential Land Inc., to correct an inconsistency between the advance and refund provisions of the agreement by making the amount of refund available to Occidential the total footage allowance of each new customer and/or load multiplied by the unit cost per foot applicable at the time the extension was originally constructed, rather than the $\$ 1.60$ per foot indicated in Resolution No. E-1706 (signed September 27, 1977). This method of refunding is in accordance with Sierra's tariff Rule No. 15, Section C.2.b.

It is found that the provisions of this amended agreement are not discriminatory, do not result in an unreasonable burden on other ratepayers, and are just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that Resolution No. E-1706, signed September 27, 1977, is amended to provide refunds to Occidential Land Inc. consistent with the increased cost of construction. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
