SUBJECT: Southern California Water Company, order authorizing tariff filing for purchased power adjustment to increase annual revenue by \$90,900 or 3.22%.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 94-E filed November 4, 1977, requests authority to increase its purchased power adjustment clause rate to become effective December 1, 1977.

RESOLUTION

The proposed revenue increase and resulting purchased power adjustment factors are shown in the following table.

The proposed increase corresponds to an increase in Southern California Edison Company's resale rates authorized by the FPC and effective September 15, 1977.

The increase in average rate per kilowatt-hour since January 1, 1976 is 23.6%. No change is made in rates for lifeline usages.
