SUBJECT: San Diego Gas & Electric Company. Order Authorizing Change in Filing Date for Annual Electric Generation Fuel Procurement Report.

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (SDG&E), by letter dated February 26, 1981, requests a change in filing date for subject report from March 31 each year to a new date consistent with its annual reasonableness review Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC) rate revision filing, for the following reasons:

1. The March 31 annual filing date was provided for in a tariff filing approved by Resolution No. E-1599, dated September 28, 1976, in connection with C-9886, the Commission's prior investigation into electric utility fuel cost offset procedures.

2. New ECAC procedure established by D-92496, in OII 56, dated December 5, 1980, allows each affected electric utility (including SDG&E) to file an annual fuel and energy procurement report as part of a particular ECAC filing each year.

3. SDG&E's annual reasonableness review ECAC filing, as provided in D-92496, is intended to result in a November 1 rate revision date, and application filing date in early September, each year.

4. It is reasonable that a single report be filed each year, covering SDG&E's reasonableness of electric generation fuel and purchased power, and that its timing be consistent with current ECAC procedures, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. San Diego Gas & Electric Company's annual report on reasonableness of electric fuel and purchased power expenses be filed on a date consistent with its November 1, ECAC revision date, instead of March 31, each year.

2. The February 26, 1981 letter request of San Diego Gas & Electric Company, for change of report filing date previously approved by Resolution No. E-1599, dated September 28, 1976, shall be marked to show that it was approved by Resolution No. E-1918 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
