TARIFF UNIT**SUBJECT:** CP National. Order Authorizing Refunds for Lassen  
and Weaverville Electric Districts.

CP NATIONAL, by Advice Letter No. C-213-E, filed March 10, 1981, requests authority to refund its customers the amount of \$64,546.00 in Lassen District, and the amount of \$9,672.00 in the Weaverville District. These refunds are associated with PG&E Refund Plans Nos. 3 and 4 under FERC Tariff Section 11C.

The Commission staff has reviewed these refund plans, and to be consistent with previous refunds and latest Commission's policies, recommends the following changes and provisions:

- (a) Payment to all customers to be made in one lump-sum, payment to be implemented not later than 60 days after the effective date of this order instead of 90 days as proposed by applicant.
- (b) Interest on all amounts, compounded monthly, shall be at the rates prescribed by Decision No. 91269, (Prime Commercial Paper rate) dated January 29, 1980, instead of 7%.
- (c) All refunds will be allocated to current customers of record during the refund month as credit to their bills, although checks will be issued if requested.
- (d) A local newspaper advertisement will be placed by CP National stating the availability of the refunds to customers.
- (e) No effort will be made to seek out former customers, but CP National will investigate all requests by former customers or by those customers who feel that the refund received was inadequate and additional refunds will be made where deemed appropriate.
- (f) Any unrefunded amounts or uncashed checks will become subject to future refund plans.


We find the proposed refund plan as modified by the staff's recommendations to be just and reasonable and in the best interest of the customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted under Sections 453.5 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code for CP National to place its proposed refund plan, modified as necessary to conform to staff's recommendations, into effect for its Needles and Weaverville Districts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 90 days after the effective date of this order the utility shall report to the Commission on the results of its refund. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
