SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY'S (SDG&E),
 REQUEST TO FOREGO FILING ITS ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT
 CLAUSE (ECAC) APPLICATION FOR ITS MARCH 1, 1983
 REVISION DATE

By Decision No. 92496, dated December 5, 1980, in OII-56, the Commission established ECAC revision dates of November 1, March 1, and July 1. The electric utilities are required to file an application 60 days prior to the revision date.

The Utility, by letter dated December 14, 1982 to the Executive Director, requests authorization not to file its ECAC application for the revision date of March 1, 1983. The utility believes that no rate change is needed.

The Commission finds that the estimated increase would be approximately \$5.0 million, which is 0.4% of SDG&E's total revenue and is not sufficient to require a rate revision. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS RESOLVED that:


1. San Diego Gas & Electric Company is authorized to forego the Energy Cost Adjustment Clause filing for the revision date of March 1, 1983.
