AUTHORIZATION FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (SCE) TO REVISE TARIFF RULES TO INCLUDE A LEVEL PAY PLAN

By Advice Letter 609-E, filed February 25, 1983, SCE requests authorization to revise its electric tariff rules as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets 7218-E to 7220-E, inclusive, to include a Level Pay Plan (LPP). The facts are as follows:

1. The revision would add a section to Rule 9, Rendering and Payment of Bills, to provide for a systemwide application of a LPP.

2. The LPP will be similar in content to the plans already on file with other major utility companies in California and approved by prior Commission actions.

3. The plan is designed to assist customers in mitigating the problem of high seasonal bills and is aimed primarily at customers with low or fixed income, but is available to all qualified customers.

4. The plan, which is optional, is open to all residential customers who have been a customer of record for 12 consecutive months and who have maintained a satisfactory payment record during that time.

5. The plan year begins on a customer's anniversary date and will run for 12 months following that date. SCE will make the plan available to customers to join at any time of the year with the plan to run for 12 months from the date of entry.

6. Under this plan a customer's anticipated bill for the l2-month period immediately following entry into the plan will be apportioned equally over the length of the plan, leaving one set amount due each month regardless of consumption.

7. The final payment month will be adjusted to take care of any debit or credit accrued due to actual consumption.

8. The equal payments will be subject to review after every rate revision, or whenever appropriate, and will be adjusted accordingly when necessary in order to avoid a large credit or debit balance in the settlement month.

9. In order to prepare mailings, train personnel, and set up computer programming, SCE requests that the provisions of the LPP be made effective on October 1, 1983.

12. This filing has been reviewed by the staff of the Rate Design and Economics Branch and approval is recommended.

13. We find this filing to be just and reasonable and responsive to the needs of the customers. It has been requested by several consumer groups and is similar in content to other such plans already approved and in use by other California utilities.

THEREFORE:

1. Under Public Utilities Code Section 532, Southern California Edison Company shall place the above tariff sheets into effect today, with a plan effective date of October 1, 1983.

2. The above advice letter and tariff sheets shall be marked to show that they were approved for filing by Resolution E-1965. This resolution is effective today.
