RESOLUTION

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (SCE) REQUESTS AUTHORIZATION TO FOREGO FILING ITS ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE (ECAC) APPLICATION FOR ITS SEPTEMBER 1, 1983 REVISION DATE

By letter dated July 1, 1983 to the Executive Director, SCE requests authorization not to file its ECAC application for a September 1, 1983 revision date. The utility's request was based on the uncertainty which existed concerning the then pending action in SCE's Application (A.) 83-03-036; its combined annual ECAC, Annual Energy Rate (AER) and reasonableness review for a May 1, 1983 revision date.

The Commission issued Decision 83-08-056 on August 17, 1983. This is an interim decision in A.83-03-036.

The Commission finds that the estimated decrease would be 0.9% and is not sufficient to require a rate revision.

THEREFORE:

1. Southern California Edison Company is authorized to forego the Energy Cost Adjustment Clause filing for a September 1, 1983 revision date. This resolution is effective today.
