RESOLUTION

REVISION OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY'S (SDG&E) RULES 15 AND 15.1 TO PROVIDE AN INCREASE IN COSTS OF OVERHEAD LINE AND UNDERGROUND EXTENSIONS

By Advice Letter 559-E Supplemental, filed February 25, 1983, SDG&E requests authorization to increase overhead line and underground extension costs as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets 4455-E through 4459-E. The facts are as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Paragraph E.2 (Periodic Review) of SDG&E's Rules Nos. 15 and 15.1, SDG&E has reviewed the cost of construction for overhead line and underground extensions.
- 2. SDG&E based its review on the costs of completed projects in 1982. The charges reflect what were anticipated March 1, 1983 construction costs.
- 3. Results of the review as stated in Advice Letter 559-E Supplemental and attachments reflect costs which have changed by more than 10 percent since the last revision of the charges for excess footage specified in Section B.3. of Rule 15. The last revision was March 3, 1981. Based on this information, SDG&E proposes to:
 (a) change the charge per frontal foot for electric underground extensions constructed within new residential subdivisions in Section C.1.a. of Rules 15.1 from \$7.10 to \$8.94; (b) change the charge per foot for electric underground extensions constructed within the new residential developments, in Section C.1.b. of Rule 15 from \$12.19 to \$17.46; (c) change the charge per foot that is used to determine the non-refundable advance for electric underground extensions constructed within new residential subdivisions, in Section C.2.(a) of Rule 15.1 from \$1.96 to \$0.65; and (d) change the charge per foot that is used to determine non-refundable advance for electric underground extensions constructed within new residential developments, in Section C.3.(b) of Rule 15.1 from \$2.81 to \$1.25.
- 4. SDG&E has furnished copies of the filing to utilities and interested parties.
- 5. The staff of the Utilities Division's Energy Service and Safety Branch has reviewed SDG&E's filing and supportive workpapers, and is of the opinion that it conforms to the 10 percent requirement of the Periodic Review paragraph of SDG&E's Rules 15 and 15.1 and recommends approval.
- 6. We find that these revisions are just and reasonable and in conformance with applicable portions of SDG&E's Rule 15 and 15.1.
