RESOLUTION

ORDER ESTABLISHING 1984 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION BUDGET FOR PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), in its compliance letter dated March 15, 1984, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078, Case No. 8209, requests approval of its underground conversion budget for 1984, in the amount of \$29,500,000. In addition, PG&E will carry forward \$2,000,000 and \$2,500,000 increases ordered for 1981 and 1982, respectively for a total of \$34,000,000.

PG&E's approved budget for 1982, as set forth in Ordering Paragraph 4, of Decision No. 82-12-069 dated December 15, 1982 was \$20,500,000. The approved budget for 1983 was \$25,000,000. By letter dated April 3, 1984, League of alifornia Cities supported PG&E's proposed budget for 1984.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-18, PG&E has allocated its conversion budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in a city or unincorporated area to the PG&E system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communications facilities to underground and that an appropriate level of such activity has been negotiated between PG&E and cities for the year 1984.

IT IS ORDERED that:

PG&E shall budget \$34,000,000 for its 1984 underground conversion program.
