## ORDER ESTABLISHING 1984 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION BUDGET FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (SCE), in its compliance letter dated December 27, 1983, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078 in Case No. 8209, requests approval for an underground conversion budget for 1984 of \$18,730,000.

SCE's approved budget for 1983 was \$18,730,000. This amount was based on the 1981 allocation and inflationary rates of 3% and 6% for the years 1982 and 1983 respectively, both of which rates were presented by SCE as being appropriate for the respective years.

The league of California Cities (LOCC) by letter dated March 23, 1984 recommended that the allocation be increased to a minimum of \$21,000,000. LOCC differs in assessment of demand for undergrounding with SCE.

The Energy Service and Safety Branch of Utilities Division has proposed that a 1984 budget allocation of \$19,100,000 be ordered by the Commission. This amount is based upon 1983 allocation and an inflationary rate of approximately 2% for the year 1984.

IT IS ORDERED that:

SCE shall budget \$19,100,000 for its 1984 underground conversion program.

This resolution is effective today.
