R E S O L U T I O N

ORDER ESTABLISHING 1985 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION  
BUDGET FOR PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGandE), in its compliance letter dated September 28, 1984, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078, Case No. 8209, requests approval of its underground conversion budget for 1985, in the amount of \$33,500,000. This includes a special allocation of \$2,000,000 in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 82-12-069.

By letter dated September 28, 1984, in accordance with Decision Nos. 82-12-069 and 83-02-065, the League of California Cities and PGandE have jointly proposed the above budget for 1985.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-18, PGandE has allocated its conversion budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in a city or unincorporated area to the PGandE system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communications facilities to underground and that an appropriate level of such activity has been negotiated between PGandE and Cities for the year 1985.

IT IS ORDERED that:

PGandE shall budget \$33,500,000 for its 1985 underground conversion program.
