RESOLUTION

ORDERING ESTABLISHING 1985 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION BUDGET FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

Southern California Edison Company (SCE), in its compliance letter dated June 7, 1985, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078 in Case 8209, requests approval for an underground conversion budget for 1985 of \$25,500,000.

SCE's approved budget for 1984 was \$19,100,000. This amount was based upon the 1983 allocation and an inflationary rate of 2% for the year 1984. The League of California Cities has expressed its support for the SCE's proposed budget for the year 1985 in view of increased demand for the undergrounding of overhead facilities.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-18, SCE shall allocate its conversion budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in a city or unincorporated area to the SCE system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communications facilities to underground and an appropriate level of such activity has been negotiated between SCE and the Cities for the year 1985.

IT IS ORDERED that:

SCE shall budget \$25,500,000 for its 1985 underground conversion program.
