RESOLUTION AMENDING  
RESOLUTION NOS. E-2004, E-1995,  
AND E-1998

By Resolutions E-2004, issued June 6, 1984, E-1995, issued January 19, 1984, and E-1998, issued March 7, 1984, the Commission approved standard form contracts between PG&E and various developers concerning overhead electric line extensions to serve residential, commercial and industrial developments in the Pacific Gas and Electric service area. These standard form contracts were adopted in response to numerous utility advice letter filings seeking deviations from filed tariffs.

The Commission now finds that:

1. Applicants' right to protest the provisions of the adopted standard form contract should be clarified.
2. The standard form agreements should be modified to add the following language:

"The provisions of this contract deviate from standard utility contract provisions, as reflected by filed tariffs. Applicants for service may protest the provisions of this contract within sixty (60) days of signature of the contract by presenting an informal request for review to be taken up by the Commission's staff. If an informal resolution is not accomplished, applicants may file a formal complaint with the Commission pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure."

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The standard form contracts approved by the Commission in Resolution Nos. E-2004, E-1995 and E-1998 be modified to add the above language.

2. Resolution Nos. E-2004, E-1995 and E-1998 are amended to reflect this modification.

This resolution is effective in 30 days.
