R E S O L U T I O N

ORDER ESTABLISHING 1986 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION  
BUDGET FOR PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

---

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGandE), in its compliance letter dated December 13, 1985, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078, Case No. 8209, requests approval of its underground conversion budget for 1986, in the amount of \$36,000,000. This includes a special allocation of \$2,000,000 in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 3a of modified Decision No. 82-12-069.

By letter dated December 13, 1985, in accordance with Decisions Nos. 82-12-069 and 83-02-065, the League of California Cities and PGandE have negotiated the above budget for 1986.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-18, PGandE has allocated its conversion budget in the same ratio that the number of overhead served meters in such city or unincorporated area of any county bears to the PGandE system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communications facilities to underground.

IT IS ORDERED that:

PGandE shall budget \$36,000,000 for its 1986 underground conversion program.
