SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Use of Direct-Fired Hydrocarbon Vaporizers.

WHEREAS: SOUTH TAHOE GAS COMPANY, by letter dated September 14, 1959, has requested that special authorization be granted, as required by Section 4.e.6 of General Order No. 94-A, to operate Algas Model 120-V direct-fired hydrocarbon vaporizers at the company's South Lake Tahoe plant, and

WHEREAS: There are adequate detailed requirements, relating to construction, installation and housing of vaporizers, which the company must follow, in Order No. 457 of the Unfired Pressure Vessel Safety Orders, issued by the State Division of Industrial Safety, and it appears that the safety of employees and the public will be adequately protected by said Safety Orders; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that South Tahoe Gas Company be granted special authority to operate Algas Model 120-W direct-fired hydrocarbon vaporizers at its South Lake Tahoe plant, such authority being required by Section 4.e.6 of General Order No. 94-A.
