SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from General Order No. 58-A.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter dated June 21, 1960, requested authorization to deviate from the provisions of Rule 25(c) of General Order No. 58-A requiring gas utilities to file with the Commission duplicate copies of meter tests requested by customers, and

WHEREAS: The Company states that complete files are kept of all tests of each meter during its service life, and that such files are readily available for use of the Commission as required; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be and it is authorized to deviate from the provisions of Rule 25(c) of General Order No. 58-A requiring that there be filed with the Commission duplicate copies of meter tests requested by customers, and is relieved from such requirement of that rule.

R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: **Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in an Increase in Rates**

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice No. 402, filed July 29, 1960, having requested authority to make a revision in the service boundary between Southern Counties Gas Company of California and Southern California Gas Company, which said revision will result in a technical increase in rates and withdrawal of service in that area transferred to Southern California Gas Company, as set forth in Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 3186-G; and

It appearing that such increased rates and withdrawal of service as will result from the above revision in the schedule of rates are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheet effective on August 28, 1960.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1125.
