SUBJECT: **Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in the Withdrawal of a Special Service**

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 519, filed July 28, 1960, has requested authority to make revisions in its filed rules as set forth in Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 8176-G, pertaining to Rule 13, and Table of Contents as set forth in Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8177-G and 8178-G, and

WHEREAS: The present rule provides, in part, that the Company may require customers to pay a reasonable installation and rental charge for each sub-meter and/or sub-regulator, or to purchase them outright, and

WHEREAS: The proposed changes in Rule 13 will eliminate such purchases or rentals and will result in more equitable treatment to all customers, we find that the modification of Company practice which will result from the above revisions in rules is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 453 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on August 27, 1960.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1126.
