SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which May Result in Decrease in Rates, Effective on less than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 521, filed August 15, 1960, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its Tariff Schedules as designated in Schedule G-60, Resale Natural Gas Service, applicable to the City of Long Beach, and Table of Contents set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8182-G to 8184-G, inclusive, effective on less than thirty day's notice, namely on August 23, 1960, which said revision will result in a reduction of \$9,000 in the amount of an increase in rates as determined by a method authorized by Resolution No. G-1122 and we find that such reduction in rates as may result from the above revision is justified; therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on August 23, 1960.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Tariff Sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1127.
