R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Transfer of Five Gas Customers Between Utilities and Sale of Utility Property Appurtenant Thereto.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter dated September 5, 1961, filed on September 7, 1961, has requested permission to transfer five gas customers with appurtenant property for the provision of such service, to the SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA and this transfer of customers and property is acceptable to the last named company; and


WHEREAS: It appears that the proposed transfer is in accordance with the intent and provisions of Commission Decision No. 56878 dated June 24, 1958, in the matter of Application No. 39636 of SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY and SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA; and therefore

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to transfer to the Southern Counties Gas Company of California, five customers located at 1634, 1636, 1636½ Potrero Grande Drive and 7843 and 7845 Alpacæ Street, Los Angeles County, with sale of appurtenant property for the provision of such gas service effective on October 1, 1961.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the communication which authorizes the transfer of customers and property as requested by the Southern California Gas Company in its letter dated September 5, 1961, shows that such authorization was granted under Resolution No. G-1152 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
