R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Main and Service Extension Rules - Southern Counties Gas Company of California.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by letter dated October 26, 1961, has requested authority under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96 and the "exceptional cases" clause of its Main and Service Extension Rules Nos. 20 and 21, to deviate from the requirements of said rules so as to construct extensions to serve the Marina del Rey Small Craft Harbor being built by the County of Los Angeles at Venice, California, without first obtaining applications, contracts and advances for such extensions; and

WHEREAS, the deviation is temporary in nature and advantageous to the County of Los Angeles and the utility, while not being a burden to existing customers, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company of California be authorized under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed Rules Nos. 20 and 21 so as to construct gas main and service extensions to serve the Marina del Rey Small Craft Harbor.
