SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Filed under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96.


WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter dated October 26, 1961 having requested authority under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96 to provide inspection and maintenance services to the gas piping system owned by the Portals Senior Citizens Village at Quartz Hill for a fee not contained in the utility's filed tariff schedules; and

WHEREAS these services and the fee therefore being minor in nature and appearing to be justified and not unreasonable; and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be authorized under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to perform these services in accordance with the terms of said contract.
