R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which will  
Result in a Technical Increase or Decrease.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 549, filed May 3, 1962, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Schedule No. G-60 set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8471-G to 8473-G, inclusive, effective on regular statutory notice, namely on June 2, 1962, and

WHEREAS: These changes are consistent with the effective natural gas resale contract between Southern California Gas Company and the City of Long Beach, and


WHEREAS: We find that such increases or decreases resulting from above revision in the schedule of rates is justified: therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on June 2, 1962.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1171.
