SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Territorial Boundary Lines.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 564, filed December 17, 1962, having requested authority under Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make adjustments to its territorial boundary line with Pacific Gas and Electric Company as set forth on the tariff sheet entitled Delano-West Bakersfield Service Area in Kern County and presented on Original P.U.C. Sheet No. 8605-G, and

WHEREAS: It appears that the proposed adjustment is in accordance with the intent and provisions of Commission Decision No. 62681, dated October 17, 1961, in Application No. 43146 of Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: Revision of a portion of the common boundary between service areas of Southern California Gas Company and Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby found to be in the public interest under these particular circumstances, and therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on regular statutory notice, namely on January 16, 1963.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheet shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1186.
