SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Territorial Boundary Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 460-G, filed February 15, 1963, having requested authority under Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make adjustments to its territorial boundary lines with Southern California Gas Company as set forth on the tariff sheets entitled "Gas Service Areas in Kern County, Detail Map No. 2" and "Bakersfield Rate Area Map No. 14", respectively presented on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7058-G and 7065-G, and

WHEREAS: It appears that the proposed adjustment is in accordance with the intent and provisions of Commission Decision No. 62681, dated October 17, 1961, in Application No. 43146, and

WHEREAS: This adjustment coincides with such a change authorized on January 8, 1963 by Resolution No. G-1186 for Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: Revision of a portion of the common boundary between service areas of Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Gas Company is hereby found to be in the public interest under these particular circumstances, and therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on regular statutory notice, namely on March 17, 1963.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1194.
