SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Temporary Contract Filed Under
Section X. A. of General Order No. 96-A.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 461-G, filed February 28, 1963 having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code and Section X. A. of G. O. 96-A to temporarily carry out the terms and conditions of a contract, dated July 23, 1962, covering gas street lighting service at the Laguna Seca Ranch Estates Subdivision, Monterey County, and

WHEREAS: Authorization of the proposed contract is to allow the utility a two year period in which to gain experience with a new type of gas service not heretofore furnished customers, therefore, good cause appearing


IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to furnish the service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms and conditions of said contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1195.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall notify the Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty days after date of termination.
