SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice, Which Will Result in Rate Decrease..

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 484-G filed January 13, 1964 having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce rates in certain of its gas service tariff schedules as designated in Table of Contents and gas service areas set forth in Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7277-G to 7309-G, inclusive to be effective on less than 30 days' notice namely on February 1, 1964; and

WHEREAS: These proposed rate area revisions will result in a decrease in charges for gas service to certain customers as of February 1, 1964, and

WHEREAS: The rates resulting from the revision of Bakersfield Rate Area Map No. 14 as set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 7286-G have actually been applied without authorization for gas service on and after March 17, 1963,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective for meter readings taken on or after February 1, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to approve retroactive to March 17, 1963, the rate zone credit adjustments for gas served in Section 14, T29S, R28E, MDB&M of the Bakersfield Rate Area.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1218.
