R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules on
Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in a
Rate Decrease.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 590 filed January 30, 1964 having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce rates in certain of its gas service Tariff Schedules as designated in Tables of Contents and as set forth in Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8953-G to 8971-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than 30 days' notice namely on February 1, 1964, and

WHEREAS: The proposed rate schedule revisions will result in a decrease in charges for gas service to customers in Terra Bella as of February 1, 1964; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective February 1, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1219.
