SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Reduction in Tariff Schedules  
on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 32-S filed February 7, 1964, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 the Public Utilities Code to reduce rates in each of its steam service tariff schedules, as designated in Table of Contents and as set forth in revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 165-H to 167-H, inclusive to be effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely for meter readings on and after March 1, 1964, and

WHEREAS: The proposed reduction in steam heat rates reflects the recently effective reduction in the cost of gas purchased by the Steam Heat Department and passed on to Steam Heat customers pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 in Decision No. 66560, dated December 27, 1963, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on March 1, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1220.
