SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Increase in Tariff Schedules
on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 3-G filed April 7, 1964, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to initiate additional gas service tariff schedules, to make certain rule changes and to increase the reconnection charge as designated in Table of Contents and as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 42-G to 53-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely, April 4, 1964, and

WHEREAS: Commission Decision No. 64420, dated October 17, 1962, in Application No. 44684 ordered the utility to provide gas service on Santa Catalina Island at a standard heating value of 1,100 Btu per cubic foot, by no later than December 31, 1964, and

WHEREAS: Increase of the reconnection charge to \$2.50 is consistent with this type of charge for electric or water service, such increase being justified, and

WHEREAS: Increase of the gas reconnection charge is hereby found to be in the public interest under these particular circumstances; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on April 4, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets will be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1226.
