**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing a Contract Modification to be Effective on Less Than Statutory Notice.

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 598, filed May 14, 1964, having requested authority under Section X.A of General Order No. 96-A and Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make modification in the terms of a contract made and entered into on March 26, 1957 and amended as of December 9, 1957 for service at the United States Gypsum Company's plant in Plaster City, California, effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely retroactive from the date of filing and authorization to April 30, 1964; and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code and Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A to amend the terms of said contract and to make the modification effective on April 30, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this supplementary letter of agreement hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1230.
