SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from the Requirements of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 599, filed June 1, 1964, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce applicable rates by rezoning to lower rate levels those certain rate areas as designated and set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9016-G, 9019-G, 9048-G through 9057-G, 9059-G through 9063-G, and 9067-G through 9069-G, to be effective on 30 days' notice, namely, July 1, 1964, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY further requests that the rates to be made effective on July 1, 1964 for the above sheets be applicable to meter readings on and after said date which is different from that required by Section IV.B. of General Order No. 96-A unless otherwise ordered or authorized, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make said effective date of such sheets applicable for meter readings taken on and after said date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1234.
