**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Rate Decrease

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION, by Advice No. 56, filed June 19, 1964 having requested authority under Sections 455, 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce present applicable rates to reflect a reduction in Federal income taxes as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 308-G through 313-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely July 1, 1964, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION further requests that the rates to be made effective on July 1, 1964, for the above sheets be applicable to meter readings on and after said date which is different from that required by Section IV.B. of General Order 96-A unless otherwise ordered or authorized, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets applicable for meter readings taken on and after July 1, 1964.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1237.
